This present document describes the intention and content of “**NorDig Accessibility Package ver. 1.1**”

NorDig release NorDig Accessibility Package ver. 1.1 to support and inform about technical possibilities for development and distribution of technical best possible accessibility services for TV users with hearing and vision disabilities.

Updates from NorDig Accessibility Package ver. 1.0 to 1.1:

- Document “Amendment to NorDig Unified Requirements specification ver. 3.2.1” is not included in this ver. 1.1 since the content / updates is now included in the updated NorDig Unified Requirements specification ver. 3.2.2.
- “**NorDig IRD and RoO ver. 3.2.2 supported Accessibility Services**” the document is updated to be in line with NorDig specifications ver. 3.2.2.

This NorDig Accessibility Package ver. 1.1 contains the 2 documents:

- “**NorDig IRD and RoO ver. 3.2.2 supported Accessibility Services**” giving an overview of the different type of accessibility services supported by NorDig specifications.
- “**Accessibility services based on HbbTV_NorDig recommendations ver. 1.0**” includes information, recommendations and implementation guidelines concerning accessibility services based on HbbTV.

NorDig IRD and RoO ver. 3.2.2 supported Accessibility Services, the purpose of this document is to be a help in developing accessibility services by giving an overview of the different type of accessibility services supported by NorDig specifications and where to find the relevant information and description. The document also includes some recommendations and implementation guidelines concerning accessibility services.

Accessibility services based on HbbTV_NorDig recommendations ver. 1.0, the purpose of this document is to be a help in planning and developing accessibility services based on HbbTV for NorDig IRDs.

HbbTV gives the possibility to develop and distribute advanced accessibility services cross platforms so the accessibility services will look and function in the same way on any NorDig IRDs with HbbTV.

The document includes information about recommendations and implementation guidelines concerning accessibility services based on HbbTV.
